A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VALUE-ADDED PRODUCTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that establishing a food 2 and product innovation network is critical to meeting the State's agricultural and economic diversification goals. The 3 4 network will allow businesses in the State to capitalize 5 globally on the "made in Hawaii" brand, create world-class products, and scale up production by providing businesses with 6 7 access to a diverse suite of manufacturing equipment and 8 industry expertise.

9 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish a
10 statewide network of open-access food and value-added product
11 development facilities to enable businesses to scale up new
12 products from research and development to manufacturing and
13 commercialization.

SECTION 2. Chapter 163D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:
