A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. (a) There is established the affordable
2	nousing land inventory task force to be placed in the office of
3	planning and sustainable development for administrative
4	purposes.
5	(b) The task force shall consist of the following members
6	or their designees:
7	(1) The director of the office of planning and sustainable
8	development, who shall serve as the chairperson;
9	(2) The comptroller of the department of accounting and
10	general services;
11	(3) The executive director of the Hawaii housing finance
12	and development corporation;
13	(4) The executive director of the Hawaii public housing
14	authority;
15	(5) The executive director of the Hawaii community
16	development authority;

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1	(6)	The executive director of the Hawaii green
2		infrastructure authority;
3	(7)	The deputy director of the highways division of the
4		department of transportation;
5	(8)	The chair of the land use commission; and
6	(9)	The chair of the public utilities commission.
7	Task forc	e members may recommend additional members with
8	appropria	te special expertise to the task force, for approval by
9	the chair	person.
10	(c)	The task force shall:
11	(1)	Update the maps, tier tables, and inventories of State
12		lands suitable and available for affordable housing
13		development in the affordable rental housing report
14		and ten-year plan that was generated pursuant to Act
15		127, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016; and
16	(2)	Submit a report of its findings and recommendations,
17		including any proposed legislation, to the legislature
18		no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
19		the regular session of 2024.



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1 The members of the task force shall serve without (d) 2 compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including 3 travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties. 4 (e) No member of the task force shall be subject to chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, solely because of the 5 6 member's participation in the task force. 7 · (f) The office of planning and sustainable development shall provide administrative and clerical support required by 8 9 the task force. 10 (q) The task force shall be dissolved on January 1, 2024. 11 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 12
