A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that in the aftermath of 2 the Lahaina wildfire, six house of representatives interim 3 working groups were established and charged with evaluating 4 specific topics related to the wildfire and making 5 recommendations for appropriate legislative action in the regular session of 2024. The wildfire prevention working group 6 was tasked to identify the causes of wildfires and preventative 7 8 action that may be taken to reduce the risk of wildfires 9 throughout the State.

10 The legislature further finds that Hawaii is the only state 11 without a state fire marshal. In 1979, the position of the 12 state fire marshal was abolished and replaced with the state 13 fire council. The state fire council is now composed of the 14 fire chiefs of the four counties, the state aircraft rescue fire 15 fighting unit, and the state protections forester from the 16 department of land and natural resources, division of forestry 17 and wildlife. The state fire council's members serve as non-





1 compensated volunteers as their time allows from their full-time 2 employment. The state fire council has an office staff 3 consisting of two part-time administrative specialists. The 4 legislature further finds that rising global temperatures have 5 increased the risk of fires and dangerous weather conditions in 6 the State and as these risks increase, the State will be better 7 served by having a dedicated state fire marshal.

8 The purpose of this Act is to enact a recommendation of the 9 wildfire prevention working group that establishes the office of 10 the state fire marshal to direct statewide efforts in preventing 11 and responding to fires throughout the State.

SECTION 2. Chapter 132, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

15 "<u>\$132-</u> Office of the state fire marshal; established.
16 (a) There is established the office of the state fire marshal
17 within the department of labor and industrial relations. The
18 office shall be headed by a state fire marshal, who shall be
19 appointed by the governor without regard to chapters 76 and 89
20 and shall not be subject to the advice and consent of the
21 senate, to serve for a period of ten years. The state fire





1	council shall submit a list of three nominees to the governor				
2	from which the governor shall appoint the state fire marshal.				
3	The state fire marshal may hire staff as necessary.				
4	(b) The state fire marshal shall have the qualifications,				
5	experience, and expertise in fire safety, prevention, and				
6	control necessary to successfully perform the duties of the				
7	position.				
8	(c)	The state fire marshal shall:			
9	(1)	Propose amendments to the state fire code for review			
10		and adoption by the state fire council;

20	(6)	Oversee the training and certification of fire			
21		inspectors and investigators in the State;

3	(8)	Administer state-level fire protection training and		
4		aid in the establishment of training facilities and		
5		programs, including statewide standardization of		
6		certification and training levels for firefighters;		
7	(9)	Assist in the disbursement of federal grants for fire		
8		protection purposes to the counties; and		
9	(10)	Perform other duties as necessary or delegated by the		
10		state fire council.		
11	(d)	In carrying out the state fire marshal's duties		
12	pursuant	to this section, the state fire marshal may utilize the		
13	services	of the state fire council advisory committee and		
14	administr	ative staff."		
15	SECTION 3. The state fire council shall submit a report of			
16	its findings and recommendations, including any proposed			
17	legislation, to the legislature by November 1, 2024. The report			
18	shall include the following, at minimum:
