SECTION 1. (a) The public utilities commission shall
direct each electric utility company in the State to file
proposals with the public utilities commission by January 1,
2025, for programs to provide benefits to residential property
owners that:

pursuant to chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes; provided that
