BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 390-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending the definition of "employer" to read as follows:

""Employer" includes any individual, partnership, 4 5 association, joint stock company, trust, corporation, the 6 personal representative of the estate of a deceased individual 7 or the receiver, trustee, or successor of any of the same, 8 employing any person $[\tau$ but shall not include the State or any 9 political subdivision thereof or the United States]." 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. 11

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
