## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1.	Section	201B-2,	Hawaii	Revised	Statutes,	is
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2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsections (b) and (c) to read:

4 "(b) The authority shall be headed by a policy-making
5 board of directors that shall consist of [twelve] <u>nine</u> members;
6 provided that:

- 7 (1) The members shall be appointed by the governor as
  8 provided in section 26-34, except as provided by this
  9 section;
- 10 (2) The members shall include at least one representative
  11 each from the city and county of Honolulu and the
  12 counties of Hawaii, Kauai, and Maui;

13 (3) Three members shall be appointed by the governor from
14 a list of three names submitted for each appointment
15 by the president of the senate, and three members
16 shall be appointed by the governor from a list of
17 three names submitted for each appointment by the



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1		speaker of the house of representatives; provided that
2		if fewer than three names are submitted for each
3		appointment, the governor may disregard the list;
4	(4)	At least [ <del>six</del> ] <u>four</u> members shall have knowledge,
5		experience, and expertise in the area of
6		accommodations, transportation, retail, entertainment,
7		or attractions, and at least one member appointed by
8		the governor shall have knowledge, experience, and
9		expertise in the area of Hawaiian cultural practices;
10		provided that [ <del>no</del> ] <u>not</u> more than [ <del>three</del> ] <u>two</u> members
11		shall represent, be employed by, or be under contract
12		to any sector of the industry represented on the
13		board;
14	(5)	One member shall be the director of business, economic
15		development, and tourism, or the director's designee,
16		who shall be an ex officio voting member;
17	(6)	The governor shall make appointments to ensure the
18		fulfillment of all requirements of paragraphs (2) and
19		(4); provided that upon the occurrence of a vacancy
20		subject to paragraph (3), the governor shall notify
21		the president of the senate and the speaker of the



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house of representatives of any unfulfilled 1 requirements pursuant to paragraphs (2) and (4), and 2 3 the president of the senate or the speaker of the house of representatives, as appropriate, shall submit 4 nominees who fulfill those requirements; [and] 5 No person who has served as a member of the board of 6 (7) 7 directors of [the-Hawaii Visitors and Convention Bureau] a current contractor of the Hawaii tourism 8 authority shall be eligible to sit as a member of the 9 board of directors of the Hawaii tourism authority 10 until at least two years have expired between the 11 person's termination from service [on the Hawaii 12 13 Visitors and Convention Bureau board] to the contractor and the person's appointment to the 14 authority's board of directors[-]; 15 No person whose business, position, or other 16 (8) 17 undertakings in which the person may have a financial 18 interest constituting a conflict of interest shall serve as member of the board of directors; and 19 20 (9) No board member shall, for a fee or other 21 consideration, act in a representative capacity or



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1	assist any person, business, or entity that has been
2	awarded a contract by the authority.
3	(c) Members shall be appointed by the governor for terms
4	of four years; provided that membership on the board shall not
5	exceed eight consecutive years; provided further that each
6	member shall [hold office until the member's successor is
7	appointed and qualified.] not continue as a holdover member
8	beyond the beginning of the next regular legislative session,
9	following the expiration of the member's term."
10	2. By amending subsection (e) to read:
11	"(e) [ <del>Seven</del> ] <u>Five</u> members shall constitute a quorum and a
12	minimum of [seven] five affirmative votes shall be necessary for
13	all actions by the authority. The members shall serve without
14	compensation, but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including
15	traveling expenses, necessary for the performance of their
16	duties."
17	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
19	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

HTA; Board Members; Holdover Position; Term Limits

#### Description:

Reduces the number of members on the Hawaii Tourism Authority Board of Directors and number of members that constitute a quorum. Makes certain amendments to membership eligibility. Prohibits holdover board members of the Hawaii Tourism Authority from holding office beyond the commencement of the next legislative session following the expiration of the member's term of office.
