A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§302A- High school athletes. (a) No public or
5	private high school shall uphold any rule, requirement,
6	standard, or other limitation preventing a student-athlete at
7	that school from earning compensation as a result of the use of
8	the student's name, image, or likeness. For private high
9	schools, earning compensation from the use of a student's name,
10	image, or likeness shall not affect the student's scholarship
11	eligibility.
12	(b) No athletic association, conference, or other group or
13	organization having authority over high school athletics,
14	including the Hawaii High School Athletic Association, shall
15	prevent:



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1	(1)	A student-athlete from earning compensation as a
2		result of the use of the student's name, image, or
3		likeness; or
4	(2)	A public or private high school from participating in
5		high school athletics as a result of the compensation
6		of a student-athlete for the use of the student's
7		name, image, or likeness.
8	(c)	No public or private high school, athletic
9	associatio	on, conference, or other group or organization having
10	authority	over high school athletics shall:
11	(1)	Provide a prospective student-athlete with
12		compensation in relation to the student-athlete's
13		name, image, or likeness; or
14	(2)	Prevent a student-athlete from obtaining professional
15		representation in relation to contracts or legal
16		matters, including representation provided by athlete
17		agents or legal representation provided by attorneys.
18	(d)	Professional representation obtained by
19	student-a	thletes shall be from persons licensed by the State.
20	Professio	nal representation by athlete agents shall be by
21	persons 1	icensed pursuant to chapter 481Z. Legal representation

4	(e) Athlete agents representing student-athletes shall
5	comply with the federal Sports Agent Responsibility and Trust
6	Act, title 15 United States Code chapter 104, in their
7	relationships with student-athletes.
8	(f) No scholarship from a private high school in which a
9	student-athlete is enrolled and that provides funding to the
10	student-athlete for the cost of attendance at that private high
11	school shall be considered compensation for the purposes of this
12	section, and no scholarship shall be revoked as a result of a
13	student-athlete earning compensation or obtaining professional
14	representation pursuant to this section.
15	(g) A student-athlete who enters into a contract providing
16	compensation to the student-athlete for use of the
17	student-athlete's name, image, or likeness shall disclose the
18	contract to an official of the public or private high school, to
19	be designated by the public or private high school.
20	(h) For purposes of this section:



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1	"Pri	vate high school" means an educational institution that		
2	teaches students in any grade from nine through twelve and that			
3	is either:			
4	(1)	Licensed; or		
5	(2)	Accredited by the Hawaii Association of Independent		
6		Schools, Hawaii Council of Private Schools, Western		
7		Association of Schools and Colleges, Western Catholic		
8		Educational Association, Association of Christian		
9		Schools International, or a similar entity recognized		
10		by the Hawaii Council of Private Schools that meets or		
11		exceeds the standards set by the entities identified		
12		herein, and submits health and safety documentation to		
13		the Hawaii Council of Private Schools or the Hawaii		
14		Catholic Schools office on an annual basis.
