4	shipment	of tobacco products if the person or entity:
5	(1)	Is engaged in the business of selling tobacco
6		products; and
7	(2)	Knowingly ships or causes to be shipped any tobacco
8		products, except cigars, to a person or entity in this
9		State that is not a licensee under this chapter.
10	(b)	This section shall not apply to the shipment of
11	[tobacco]	<u>:</u>
12	(1)	Large or little cigars; or
13	(2)	Tobacco products if any of the following conditions
14		are met:
15	[(1)]	(A) The tobacco products are exempt from taxes as
16		provided by section 245-3(b); or

1	[(2)] (B) All applicable state taxes on the tobacco products
2	are paid in accordance with the requirements of
