A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEFAMATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that defamation lawsuits				
2	are sometimes brought against individuals who are making				
3	truthful claims about sexual misconduct, which can be used to				
4	silence victims. The threat of lawsuits may negatively impact				
5	victims attempting to report sexual misconduct. Therefore,				
6	providing additional protections to individuals who make				
7	truthful claims about sexual misconduct will create safer				
8	communities for Hawaiʻi's people.				
9	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to protect				
10	individuals making claims of sexual misconduct from defamation				
11	lawsuits unless the claim is made with malice.				
12	SECTION 2. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
13	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated				
14	and to read as follows:				

15 "<u>\$663-</u> Defamation limited in cases of sexual assault, 16 sexual harassment, and sexual discrimination. (a) No

1	individual shall be liable in damages in any defamation action				
2	for making a protected communication without malice.				
3	(b) A prevailing defendant in any defamation action				
4	brought against the defendant for making a protected				
5	communication shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees				
6	and costs.				
7	(c) For the purposes of this section, "protected				
8	communication" means factual information related to any incident				
9	of sexual assault, sexual harassment, or sex discrimination,				
10	experienced by the individual making the communication,				
11	including but not limited to:				
12	(1) Any discrimination on the basis of sex pursuant to				
13	section 378-2;				
14	(2) Any discrimination on the basis of sex pursuant to				
15	section 515-3;				
16	(3) Any sexual offenses included in part V of chapter 707;				
17	and				
18	(4) Any retaliation for reporting or opposing sexual				
19	assault, sexual harassment, or sex discrimination."				
20	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
