A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OAHU REGIONAL HEALTH CARE SYSTEM, HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is currently 2 no state veterans home to serve the needs of the veterans 3 community on the island of Maui. State veterans homes are 4 facilities that provide long-term care and rehabilitation care 5 for veterans, their spouses, and gold-star parents. State 6 veterans homes are funded primarily through the United States 7 Department of Veterans Affairs and medicare or medicaid funds. 8 The legislature further finds that development plans for 9 the construction of the Maui state veterans home is currently 10 being undertaken by the department of defense. However, 11 management, operation, and staffing of the Maui state veterans 12 home should be placed under a state agency able to manage a 13 long-term care facility.

14 The purpose of this Act is to transfer the Maui state
15 veterans home to the Oahu regional health care system or another
16 state agency.

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1	SECTION 2. Section 323F-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:	
3	"(b) The corporate organization shall be divided into five	
4	regional systems, as follows:	
5	(1)	The Oahu regional health care system[+], which may
6		include the state veterans home on Maui;
7	(2)	The Kauai regional health care system;
8	(3)	The Maui regional health care system;
9	(4)	The east Hawaii regional health care system,
10		comprising the Puna district, north Hilo district,
11		south Hilo district, Hamakua district, and Kau
12		district; and
13	(5)	The west Hawaii regional health care system,
14		comprising the north Kohala district, south Kohala
15		district, north Kona district, and south Kona
16		district;
17	and shall	be identified as regional systems I, II, III, IV, and
18	V, respectively."	
19	SECTION 3. (a) No later than June 30, 2027, the Maui	
20	state veterans home on Maui shall be assimilated into the Oahu	
21	regional	health care system or another state agency in a manner



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1 and to an extent that may be negotiated between the Oahu 2 regional health care system or another state agency and the 3 department of defense. After assimilation, the physical assets 4 and the ground lease of the Maui state veterans home shall 5 become property of the Oahu regional health care system or another state agency, and the Maui state veterans home shall be 6 7 managed by the Oahu regional health care system or another state 8 agency.

9 (b) None of the liabilities of the Maui state veterans 10 home in existence at the time the Maui state veterans home is 11 assimilated into the Oahu regional health care system or another 12 state agency shall become liabilities of the Oahu regional 13 health care system or another state agency.

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SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
