RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. (a) The department of human services shall
 develop a safe parking program allowing unsheltered persons who
 sleep in their vehicles to park on state lands overnight.

4 (b) The office of planning and sustainable development5 shall identify state lands that are suitable for the program.

6 (c) The department of human services and office of
7 wellness and resilience shall coordinate with homeless service
8 providers to determine how needed services, including access to
9 showers, laundry facilities, and medical assessments, can be
10 provided to program participants on a mobile basis.

(d) The department of human services shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including a detailed plan for the safe parking program and any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2025.
