
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
2 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
4 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023,
5 and this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure
6 ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
7 \$ or per cent. This current declaration takes
8 into account general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal
9 year 2024-2025 in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, and this Act
10 only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure
11 ceiling are that:

12 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
13 serve the public interest; and

14 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
15 addressed by this Act.

16 SECTION 2. The following positions are established within
17 the department of law enforcement:



- 1 (1) Eleven full-time equivalent (11.0 FTE) deputy sheriff
- 2 positions; and
- 3 (2) Four full-time equivalent (4.0 FTE) permanent
- 4 supervisory deputy sheriff positions.

5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
8 an additional fifteen full-time equivalent (15.0 FTE) deputy
9 sheriff positions for law enforcement officer activities in
10 Lahaina and Maui.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
12 law enforcement for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2042.
