# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the performance of  
2 work by university employees is a matter of statewide concern  
3 pursuant to article X, section 6, of the Hawaii State  
4 Constitution.

5           SECTION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
6 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately  
7 designated and to read as follows:

8           "§304A-     Annual report; employees working outside of the  
9 State. No later than December 31 of each year, the university  
10 shall submit an annual report to the legislature of all  
11 university employees who performed work from a location outside  
12 of the State for more than sixty consecutive days during the  
13 applicable year. The report shall include, for each employee  
14 who performed work from a location outside of the State, the  
15 position, position description, salary range, and duration of  
16 time spent performing work from a location outside of the  
17 State."



- 1 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.



**Report Title:**

UH; Employees; Telework; Report

**Description:**

Requires the University of Hawaii to submit to the Legislature annual reports of all university employees who performed work from a location outside of the State for more than sixty consecutive days during the applicable year no later than December 31 of that year. (SD1)
