### A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR WILDFIRE RECOVERY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the devastating
 wildfires brought on by winds from Hurricane Dora on August 8,
 2023, resulted in one of the worst natural disasters in the
 State's history. The wildfires caused loss of life and
 displacement of thousands on the island of Maui. The disaster
 also destroyed nearly all of Lahaina.

7 The people of Hawaii and the world responded 8 compassionately by coming together with donation drives and 9 relief efforts to support those on Maui who had survived the 10 devastation. Federal, state, and county agencies worked 11 together with nonprofit organizations, including the American 12 Red Cross, Hawaii Community Foundation, Maui United Way, and 13 many others, on the emergency response and recovery efforts.

14 The legislature further finds that to support response and 15 recovery efforts and address immediate 2023 wildfire funding 16 needs, the governor, through the seventh emergency proclamation 17 relating to wildfires, dated September 8, 2023, and executive

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1 memorandum no. 23-08, redirected \$164.1 million, after 2 adjustments, from selected general fund operating appropriations 3 from Act 164, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, originally intended 4 for specific purposes and capital improvement projects, to the 5 department of budget and finance. The department of budget and 6 finance subsequently transferred \$65 million to the major 7 disaster fund and set aside the remaining \$99.1 million for the 8 State's share of noncongregate housing and debris clean-up costs 9 initially being paid by the Federal Emergency Management Agency. 10 These steps, among others, allowed the State to address response 11 and recovery expenses incurred thus far without cutting 12 positions and departmental base budgets. 13 The purpose of this Act is to continue the Hawaii wildfires

13 The purpose of this Act is to continue the Hawaii wildfires
14 disaster response and recovery efforts by:

- 15 (1) Appropriating \$452.2 million relating to the State's
  16 response to the Maui wildfires and statewide wildfire
  17 mitigation and response; and
- 18 (2) Reauthorizing \$160.2 million of general funded capital
   19 improvement project operating appropriations as
- 20 general obligation bond funded appropriations.

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SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the state risk
 management revolving fund established by section 41D-4, Hawaii
 Revised Statutes, the sum of \$200,000,000 or so much thereof as
 may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for insurance claim
 payments related to the Hawaii wildfires disaster that began on
 August 8, 2023.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 8 accounting and general services, state risk management and 9 insurance administration (AGS 203), for the purposes of this 10 section, with the approval of the comptroller.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$186,160,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 as a set-aside for recovery costs for the Hawaii wildfires disaster that began on August 8, 2023.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 17 budget and finance, departmental administration and budget 18 division (BUF 101), for the purposes of this section; provided 19 that, any law to the contrary notwithstanding, the governor may 20 authorize the transfer of up to \$186,160,000 in general funds to 21 other state agencies for recovery costs for the Hawaii wildfires

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1 disaster that began on August 8, 2023; provided further that the governor shall submit a report to the legislature within five 2 3 days of each use of this authority; provided further that the report shall include the date of transfer, the amount of the 4 5 transfer, the program ID to which funds were transferred, and an 6 explanation of the purpose of the transfer of resources; and 7 provided further that the governor shall submit to the 8 legislature a summary report containing the aforementioned 9 information for each use of this authority for the previous 10 twelve month period from December 1 to November 30 no later than 11 thirty days prior to the convening of the regular sessions of 12 2025 and 2026.

SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$182,238 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for three full-time equivalent (3.0 FTE) positions in the department of business, economic development, and tourism, statewide planning and coordination special plans branch, for Maui recovery efforts.



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The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 1 business, economic development, and tourism, statewide planning 2 3 and coordination (BED 144), for the purposes of this section. 4 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$125,000 or so much 6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for 7 temporary libraries located in Makawao and Lahaina, Maui. 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii state 9 public library system, public libraries (EDN 407) for the 10 purposes of this section. 11 SECTION 6. (a) The department of human services is 12 authorized to fund six full-time equivalent (6.0 FTE) temporary 13 positions to be funded by federal funds. 14 There is appropriated out of the general revenues of (b) 15 the State of Hawaii the sum of \$13,370,000 or so much thereof as 16 may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025, and the sum of 17 \$12,751,554 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 18 year 2024-2025 in federal funds for emergency management related 19 to the Hawaii wildfires that began on August 8, 2023.

2	department of human services, general administration - DHS			
3	(HMS 904), for the purposes of this section.			
4	SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the conservation			
5	and resources enforcement special fund established by section			
6	199-1.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the sum of \$521,473 or so much			
7	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the			
8	department of land and natural resources, conservation and			
9	resources enforcement, for Maui wildfire recovery efforts.			
10	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of			
11	land and natural resources, conservation and resources			
12	enforcement (LNR 405), for the purposes of this section.			
13	SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general			
14	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$653,082 or so much			
15	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to the			
16	Hawaii emergency management agency to establish twenty full-time			
17	equivalent (20.0 FTE) permanent positions for Maui wildfire			
18	recovery.			
19	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii			
20	emergency management agency (DEF 118) for the purposes of this			
21	section.			



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1 SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the public 2 utilities commission special fund established by section 269-33, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the sum of \$1,000,000 or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for 4 5 consultant contracts for utility dockets. 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the public utilities commission (CCA 901) for the purposes of this section. 7 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general 8 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$20,000,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for 10 wildfire response, recovery, and prevention measures. 11 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 13 Hawaiian home lands, administration and operating support 14 (HHL 625), for the purposes of this section. 15 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$7,425,000 or so much 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for fire response and rehabilitation and wildfire fuels reduction 18 19 contracts for the department of land and natural resources, 20 division of forestry and wildlife.

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The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
 land and natural resources, native resources and fire protection
 program (LNR 402), for the purposes of this section.

SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general
revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$10,000,000 or so
much thereof as may be necessary for fire and emergency response
equipment.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 9 land and natural resources, native resources and fire protection 10 program (LNR 402), for the purposes of this section.

SECTION 13. There is appropriated out of the public utilities commission special fund established under section 269-33, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the sum of \$900,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for consultant contracts for utility dockets.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the division of 17 consumer advocacy (CCA 103) for the purposes of this section. 18 SECTION 14. The director of finance is authorized to issue 19 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$2,360,000 and the same 20 sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated for 21 fiscal year 2024-2025 for the purpose of West Maui and Upcountry

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Maui fire prevention, erosion control, and fire suppression dip
 tanks.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 4 land and natural resources, native resources and fire protection 5 program (LNR 402), for the purposes of this section.

6 SECTION 15. The director of finance is authorized to issue
7 reimbursable general obligation bonds in the sum of \$63,560,000
8 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is
9 appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025 as follows:

10 (1) \$4,560,000 for a final disposition site;

11 (2) \$11,000,000 for wastewater collection system repairs;

- 12 (3) \$9,000,000 for wastewater collection system laterals
- 13 and cleanouts;
- 14 (4) \$3,000,000 for traffic signal replacement;
- 15 (5) \$10,000,000 for fire flow improvements to water 16 systems;
- 17 (6) \$10,000,000 for water supply infrastructure repairs
  18 and replacements;
- 19 (7) \$8,000,000 for storm drainage, flood control, and
  20 water quality improvements; and

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1	(8) \$8,000,000 for roadway connectivity for disaster
2	evacuation.
3	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of
4	Maui through (SUB 401) for the purposes of this section.
5	SECTION 16. The following sums or so much thereof as may
6	be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 are appropriated or
7	authorized, as the case may be, from moneys in the treasury
8	received from revenue bond funds and federal grants to finance
9	the project listed below. The letter symbols used after the
10	specific project appropriations indicate the source of financing
11	and have the following meaning: (E) revenue bond funds, (N)
12	federal funds.
