BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 84-11.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Every legislator and employee shall file a gifts "(a) 4 disclosure statement with the state ethics commission no later 5 than June 30 of each year if all the following conditions are 6 met: 7 (1)The legislator or employee, or spouse or dependent child of a legislator or employee, received directly 8 9 or indirectly from one source any gift or gifts valued 10 singly or in the aggregate in excess of [\$200,] \$50, 11 whether the gift is in the form of money, service, 12 goods, or in any other form; The source of the gift or gifts have interests that 13 (2) 14 may be affected by official action or lack of action 15 by the legislator or employee; and 16 (3) The gift is not exempted by subsection (d) from 17 reporting requirements under this subsection."
