### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

#### **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 27-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 The department of education, department of health, "(a) 4 department of corrections and rehabilitation, department of 5 defense, and University of Hawaii system shall each ensure that 6 a certain percentage of the food purchased for public schools, 7 youth campuses, public hospitals, public prisons, and any 8 purchases made directly by the University of Hawaii for use in its academic programs, as applicable, is fresh local 9 10 agricultural products and local value-added, processed, 11 agricultural, or food products, as follows: By January 1, 2025, fresh local agricultural products 12 (1)13 and local value-added, processed, agricultural, or 14 food products shall constitute a minimum of ten per 15 cent of the total food purchased during each calendar 16 year, as measured by the per cent of total food cost;

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1	(2)	By January 1, 2030, fresh local agricultural products
2		and local value-added, processed, agricultural, or
3		food products shall constitute a minimum of eighteen
4		per cent of the total food purchased during each
5		calendar year, as measured by the per cent of total
6		food cost;
7	(3)	By January 1, 2035, fresh local agricultural products
8		and local value-added, processed, agricultural, or
9		food products shall constitute a minimum of twenty-six
10		per cent of the total food purchased during each
11		calendar year, as measured by the per cent of total
12		food cost;
13	(4)	By January 1, 2040, fresh local agricultural products
14		and local value-added, processed, agricultural, or
15		food products shall constitute a minimum of
16		thirty-four per cent of the total food purchased
17		during each calendar year, as measured by the per cent
18		of total food cost;
19	(5)	By January 1, 2045, fresh local agricultural products
20		and local value-added, processed, agricultural, or
21		food products shall constitute a minimum of forty-two

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1		per cent of the total food purchased during each	
2		calendar year, as measured by the per cent of total	
3		food cost; [and]	
4	(6)	By January 1, 2050, fresh local agricultural products	
5		and local value-added, processed, agricultural, or	
6		food products shall constitute a minimum of fifty per	
7		cent of the total food purchased during each calendar	
8		year, as measured by the per cent of total food	
9		cost[-]; and	
10	(7)	By January 1, , fresh local agricultural products	
11		and local value-added, processed, agricultural, or	
12		food products shall constitute one hundred per cent of	
13		the total food purchased during each calendar year, as	
14		measured by the per cent of total food cost."	
15	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
16	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

Report Title:

Produce Contracts; Local Produce; Benchmarks

#### Description:

Requires that, by a certain date, 100% of the food purchased by certain state departments consist of fresh local agricultural products and local value-added, processed, agricultural, or food products.

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
