A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CANNABIS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the purpose of the 1 2 State's medical cannabis dispensary system law is to ensure that qualifying patients have safe, timely, and adequate access to 3 medical cannabis. The legislature further finds that the 4 5 coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic has severely impacted the way in which qualifying patients can safely access 6 7 the facilities that provide medical cannabis. Many qualifying patients suffer from debilitating conditions that make them 8 9 especially vulnerable to COVID-19 exposure and seek alternative 10 ways to physically access facilities to minimize exposure.

11 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the department of 12 health to allow in-vehicle receipt of medical cannabis and 13 medical cannabis products by qualifying patients or their 14 primary caregiver on the premises of dispensaries under certain 15 conditions.

16 SECTION 2. Section 329D-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 17 amended by amending subsection (n) to read as follows:

3	products to a qualifying patient, primary caregiver, qualifying
4	out-of-state patient, or caregiver of a qualifying out-of-state
5	patient[+] outside of the dispensary's retail store building;
6	provided that the department may allow a dispensary to dispense
7	cannabis or manufactured cannabis products to a qualifying
8	patient or primary caregiver of a qualifying patient outside of
9	the dispensary's retail store building but on the dispensary's
10	premises; provided further that the department shall adopt rules
11	detailing the circumstances and requirements under which
12	dispensing may be allowed pursuant to this subsection, including
13	rules for the dispensing of cannabis or manufactured cannabis
14	products to a qualifying patient or primary caregiver of a
15	qualifying patient who takes delivery while in a motor vehicle
16	on the dispensary's premises."
17	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
18	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were

19 begun before its effective date.

20 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

Description:

Authorizes the Department of Health to allow dispensaries to dispense cannabis or manufactured cannabis products to qualifying patients or primary caregivers of qualifying patients outside of the dispensary's retail store building but on the dispensary's premises. Requires the Department of Health to adopt rules, including rules for dispensing to a qualifying patient or primary caregiver of a qualifying patient who takes delivery while in a motor vehicle on the dispensary's premises.
