BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 321-481, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by amending the definition of "community care foster
 family home" to read as follows:

4 ""Community care foster family home" or "home" means a home

(1)	Is regulated by the department in accordance with
	rules that are equitable in relation to rules that
	govern expanded adult residential care homes;
(2)	Is issued a certificate of approval by the department
	or its designee to provide, for a fee, twenty-four-
	hour living accommodations, including personal care
	and homemaker services, for not more than two adults
	at any one time, at least one of whom shall be a
	medicaid recipient, who are at the nursing facility
	level of care, who are unrelated to the foster family,
	and who are receiving the services of a licensed home

1 only to the extent, necessary to effectuate this intent, the 2 governor may modify the strict provisions of this Act, but shall 3 promptly report any modification with reasons therefor to the 4 legislature at its next regular session thereafter for review by 5 the legislature.

6 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
