A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§304A-105 Powers of regents; official name. (a) The board of regents shall have management and control of the 4 5 general affairs, and exclusive jurisdiction over the internal structure, management, and operation of the university. The 6 7 board may:

Authorize any officer, elected or appointed by it, to 10 (2) approve and sign on its behalf any voucher or other 11 document that the board may approve and sign; 12

Delegate to the president or the president's designee 13 (3) the authority to render the final decision in 14 contested case proceedings subject to chapter 91, as 15 16 it deems appropriate;

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Purchase or otherwise acquire lands, buildings, 1 (4)2 appliances, and other property for the purposes of the 3 university; and 4 Expend any sums of money as, from time to time, may be (5) 5 placed at the disposal of the university from whatever 6 source; provided that notwithstanding any other law to 7 the contrary, all documents regarding expenditures and 8 changes thereto, made by the board shall be disclosed 9 in open meetings for the purpose of public comment; provided further that all expenditure requests, 10 11 proposals, and any other budgetary documents used by 12 the board at an open meeting shall be made available to the public at least six calendar days before the 13 14 meeting. 15 All lands, buildings, appliances, and other property so purchased or acquired shall be and remain the property of the 16 17 university to be used in perpetuity for the benefit of the university. The board, in accordance with this section and 18

19 other law, shall manage the inventory, equipment, surplus20 property, and expenditures of the university and, subject to

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chapter 91, may adopt rules [7] further controlling and
 regulating the same.

3 (b) The board of regents shall develop internal policies
4 and procedures for the procurement of goods, services, and
5 construction, consistent with the powers of the board [set
6 forth] described in section 304A-2672, and the goals of public
7 accountability and public procurement practices, subject to
8 chapter 103D.

9 (c) The board of regents may enter into concession10 agreements without regard to chapter 102.

11 (d) If the chairperson of the board of regents is named in 12 any legislation to serve or participate as a voting or nonvoting member of any board, commission, working group, task force, or 13 14 otherwise, and the chairperson is authorized to select a 15 designee to serve or participate in place of the chairperson, the designee shall be approved by the board of regents subject 16 17 to the quorum and majority requirements of section 304A-104(c). 18 $\left[\frac{d}{d}\right]$ (e) The official name of the board shall be the 19 board of regents, University of Hawaii. The board shall adopt 20 and use a common seal by which all official acts shall be 21 authenticated."

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SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
