### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish a
working group to assess and make recommendations on the most
appropriate regulatory framework and licensure requirements for
school psychologists in the State.
SECTION 2. (a) There is established a working group

6 within the Department of Education for administrative purposes 7 only. The working group shall research and explore the idea of 8 establishing a regulatory framework and licensure requirements 9 for school psychologists in the State.

10 (b) The working group shall address and make11 recommendations on:

- 12 (1) The appropriate regulatory framework for school
- 13 psychologists in the State, including the most
- 14 appropriate board or agency to administer, implement,
- 15 and enforce the regulation;
- 16 (2) The appropriate licensing criteria for school
- 17 psychologists in the State, including but not limited



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1		to the work or type of work the individuals will need
2		to complete to be licensed;
3	(3)	Concerns raised by the office of the auditor in Report
4		No. 22-13, issued in November 2022, including but not
5		limited to the appropriate definition of the practice
6		of school psychology that should be subject to the
7		regulation; and
8	(4)	Any other issues that may arise, pursuant to the
9		discretion of the working group.
10	(c)	The working group shall consist of the following
11	members:	
12	(1)	The superintendent of education, or the
13		superintendent's assignee, who shall serve as
14		chairperson of the working group;
15	(2)	The administrator of the professional and vocational
16		licensing division of the department of commerce and
17		consumer affairs, or the administrator's assignee;
18	(3)	One member of the board of psychology; and
19	(4)	One member of the Hawaii Association of School
20		Psychologists, to be invited by the chairperson of the
<b>2</b> 1		working group.



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1 The working group shall report its findings and (d) 2 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 3 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 4 the regular session of 2025. 5 (e) The members of the working group shall serve without 6 compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including 7 travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties. 8 (f) No member of the working group shall be subject to 9 chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, solely because of the 10 member's participation in the working group. 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on December 31,

12 2050.
