BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 342F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
and to read as follows:
"§342F- Helicopters; public nuisance; noise pollution;
private right of action; exceptions. (a) Any helicopter that
generates a sound level of more than decibels for bass
sound, measured using the dBC weighting system, from a
complainant's site at ground level, shall constitute a public
nuisance and a source of noise pollution in violation of this
chapter.
(b) The department may accept decibel readings gathered by
complainants as evidence of a violation of this chapter.
(c) Any owner or operator of a helicopter in violation of
this section shall be subject to a fine of not less than
<pre>\$ for the first offense and not less than</pre>
<pre>\$ for each subsequent offense.</pre>

1	(d) Any person who is aggrieved by a violation of this
2	section shall have a private right of action and may bring a
3	civil action against the owner or operator of the helicopter in
4	the district court of the district in which the violation
5	occurred to enjoin further violations and to recover times
6	the person's actual damages or \$ for each violation,
7	whichever sum is greater. A person bringing an action pursuant
8	to this subsection shall also be entitled to recover the costs
9	of the suit, including reasonable attorney's fees.
10	(e) This section shall not apply to:
11	(1) Any helicopter:
12	(A) Owned or operated by a government agency or
13	organization; or
14	(B) Used to supply emergency services such as
15	emergency aeromedical services or search and
16	rescue services; and
17	(2) Decibel readings taken at any ground-level site
18	located within a -mile radius of an airport."
