## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

## ENCOURAGING THE UNITED STATES NAVY TO ERADICATE OCTOCORAL AND OTHER INVASIVE SPECIES FROM THE WATERS OF PEARL HARBOR.

WHEREAS, two invasive species of octocoral, or Unomia 1 stolonifera and Capnella spicata, are two of many invasive 2 3 species that threaten Pearl Harbor's maritime ecosystem; and 4 5 WHEREAS, octocoral takes over marine habitats extremely quickly because it is a "soft coral" that does not form a 6 calcium exoskeleton like reef-building corals, allowing it to 7 rapidly grow and spread colonies, smothering Hawaiian coral reef 8 9 ecosystems; and 10 WHEREAS, in areas where octocorals dominate the marine 11 habitat, there is a lower density and diversity of fish; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, the United States Navy reported the presence of octocoral near Pearl Harbor in late 2020 during surveys that 15 were not focused on octocorals, and recent surveys have 16 documented octocoral in a much larger area, indicating that they 17 were most likely present before 2019; and 18 19 WHEREAS, a strong, unified response is required to remove 20 and eradicate octocorals and other invasive species from the 21 waters of Pearl Harbor; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the United States Navy is the principal caretaker 24 of Pearl Harbor and its waters; now, therefore, 25 26 27 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the 28 House of Representatives concurring, that the United States Navy 29 is encouraged to eradicate octocoral and other invasive species 30 from the waters of Pearl Harbor; and 31 32

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United States Navy is
encouraged to allocate resources to eradicate octocoral and
other invasive species from the waters of Pearl Harbor,
including West Loch, Middle Loch, and East Loch; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United States Navy is urged 7 to provide the state Department of Land and Natural Resources 8 with regular updates on the status of eradication efforts and 9 the extent of invasive octocoral; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 12 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the United States 13 Secretary of the Navy and Chairperson of the Board of Land and 14 Natural Resources.
