SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII MEDICAL ASSOCIATION AND HAWAII PSYCHIATRIC MEDICAL ASSOCIATION TO CONVENE A ROUNDTABLE TO ESTABLISH MEDICAL PROTOCOLS TO ENSURE THAT AN INDIVIDUAL'S THYROID FUNCTION IS TESTED BEFORE PSYCHOTROPIC MEDICATIONS FOR MENTAL ILLNESS ARE PRESCRIBED.

WHEREAS, doctors and others who have prescriptive authority 1 often appropriately prescribe psychotropic medications to treat 2 individuals who have a mental illness; and 3 4 WHEREAS, literature and experience demonstrates that 5 sometimes individuals who have a thyroid condition may present 6 7 symptoms similar to mental illness; and 8 WHEREAS, there have been instances where these individuals 9 have been prescribed psychotropic medications without testing 10 for the presence of a thyroid condition; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, subsequent testing has revealed that some individuals in fact had a thyroid condition and not a mental 14 illness and that the psychotropic medications they received were 15 either ineffective or potentially harmful; and 16 17 WHEREAS, testing for abnormal thyroid levels is a simple 18 process that can be done through a blood test; now, therefore, 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the 22 House of Representatives concurring, that the Hawaii Medical 23 Association and Hawaii Psychiatric Medical Association is 24 requested to convene a roundtable to establish medical protocols 25 to ensure that an individual's thyroid function is tested before 26 27 psychotropic medications for mental illness are prescribed; and 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 29 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the 30
