## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

	REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PRIORITIZE REMEDIATION OF THE FLOODING ISSUES PRESENT ON ROUTE 11 AROUND MILE POST SIXTY AS A SAFETY PROJECT.
1 2 3	WHEREAS, there is well-documented flooding on Route 11 near Mile Post 60, on Hawaii Island; and
3 4 5 6	WHEREAS, flooding frequently causes the highway to close; and
7 8 9 10	WHEREAS, Route 11 is a portion of Mamalahoa Highway that acts as the main artery into the southern tip of the island, and is also the only route that connects the two main towns of the Ka'ū district; and
11 12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, the closure of this highway poses a major safety issue for the surrounding residents, being their lifeline to medical services and an emergency evacuation route; and
15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, the highway was constructed before 1962 and lacks drainage elements within this low-lying section; and
19 20 21	WHEREAS, Mamalahoa Highway has closed at least six times since 2012 due to flooding; and
22 23 24	WHEREAS, the Legislature has previously included funds for maintenance of this highway in the budget and attempted to pass remedial legislation; and
25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has considered installing flood monitoring systems and raising the highway as much as ten feet and installing culverts; now, therefore,
29 30 31 32 33	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of Transportation is requested to prioritize remediation of the
