SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING CONGRESS TO TAKE IMMEDIATE AND DECISIVE ACTION TO SUPPORT MIDDLE- AND LOWER-INCOME HOUSEHOLDS IN AMERICA.

WHEREAS, the United States faces an ongoing crisis of 1 inequality with middle- and lower-income households bearing the 2 brunt of economic hardship; and 3 4 WHEREAS, access to affordable health care remains a 5 critical issue, with millions of Americans lacking adequate 6 coverage, resulting in preventable illnesses and deaths; and 7 8 WHEREAS, the coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic exacerbated 9 existing disparities, disproportionately impacting marginalized 10 communities and underscoring the importance of a robust public 11 12 health infrastructure and equitable access to health care services; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the nation continues to witness an alarming number 15 of traffic fatalities, shootings, suicides, and incidents of 16 domestic violence, highlighting the urgent need for 17 comprehensive solutions to address underlying social and mental 18 health issues; and 19 20 WHEREAS, despite being one of the wealthiest nations in the 21 22 world, the United States ranks poorly in numerous health and social indicators, reflecting systemic failures in addressing 23 the needs of its most vulnerable members of society; and 24 25 WHEREAS, it is the duty of Congress to prioritize the well-26 being of all citizens and enact legislation that promotes 27 fairness, justice, and opportunity for every individual; and 28 29 WHEREAS, the United States is grappling with the staggering 30 costs of living, including skyrocketing housing prices, 31 exorbitant childcare expenses, and the ever-increasing burden of 32 33 student-loan debt that disproportionately affects middle- and

lower-income families, hindering their ability to achieve 1 financial stability and social mobility; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the nation also faces an escalating housing crisis 4 characterized by a severe shortage of affordable housing units, 5 rising rents, low wages that are incongruent with the respective 6 estimates of the cost of living in cities throughout the 7 country, and rampant homelessness, leaving millions of Americans 8 precariously housed or without shelter altogether and further 9 exacerbating economic insecurity and perpetuating cycles of 10 poverty; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the urgency of this situation demands swift and 13 14 concerted action from Congress to address the multifaceted challenges facing the middle- and lower-income households in 15 16 America; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the failure to act decisively will perpetuate the decline in the infrastructure of the American public health 19 apparatus and deepen the divide between social classes; now, 20 therefore, 21 22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 23 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, 24 25 that Congress is urged to take immediate and decisive action to support middle- and lower-income households in America; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Congress is specifically urged 28 29 to: 30 Implement policies to ensure universal access to 31 (1)affordable health care, including the expansion of 32 Medicaid and the establishment of a public option; 33 34 (2) Enact comprehensive gun control measures to reduce the 35 incidence of shootings and promote community safety; 36 37 (3) Invest in mental health resources and support services 38 39 to address the root causes of suicide and domestic violence; 40 41
