## SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO CARRY OUT WIDESPREAD SOIL TESTING IN LAHAINA AND TO DEVELOP A SOIL REMEDIATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, in August 2023, Lahaina, on the island of Maui, 1 2 experienced the fifth deadliest wildfire in United States 3 history; and 4 5 WHEREAS, more than two thousand two hundred structures were damaged or destroyed in Lahaina and West Maui, eighty-six 6 percent of which were residences; and 7 8 WHEREAS, high-intensity wildfires such as the wildfire 9 10 experienced in Lahaina cause physical, chemical, and biological 11 changes to the surrounding soil; and 12 WHEREAS, burned or melted building materials, furniture, 13 14 plastics, and consumer electronics produce toxic substances that can also contaminate soil; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, soil contamination caused by the Lahaina wildfire may threaten human health, groundwater quality, ocean 18 19 ecosystems, and food production; now, therefore, 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 21 22 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, that the Department of Health is requested to: 23 24 25 (1)Sample and test the soil at numerous burn sites in Lahaina for toxins and contaminants; 26 27 28 (2) Develop a soil remediation plan for areas of Lahaina 29 where soil contamination threatens human health, groundwater quality, ocean ecosystems, or food 30 31 production; 32 33 (3) Assess the feasibility of using available technologies to separate clean soil from ash and toxins; and 34 35

(4) 1 Submit a report of the Department's findings and recommendations, including the expected costs and 2 estimated timeline for any needed soil remediation 3 projects, and any proposed legislation, to the 4 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the 5 convening of the Regular Session of 2025; and 6 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 8 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health and Mayor of 9 10 the County of Maui. 11 12 13
