SENATE RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE HAWAII EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO SUBMIT A GRANT REQUEST TO THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR ROCKFALL MITIGATION IN MOANALUA GARDENS AND MOANALUA VALLEY, OAHU.

WHEREAS, boulders along hillsides pose a threat of 1 dangerous rockfalls and landslides that could directly and 2 indirectly impact communities across the State; and 3 4 WHEREAS, rockfall mitigation projects require proactive 5 6 measures to protect hillside and valley communities; and 7 8 WHEREAS, on Oahu, the Moanalua Gardens and Moanalua Valley communities are considered a high risk zone for landslides and 9 rockfalls; and 10 11 WHEREAS, certain hillsides surrounding Moanalua Valley are 12 owned by the federal government, such as Tripler Army Medical 13 14 Center; and 15 WHEREAS, the United States Army Corps of Engineers has 16 previously conducted rockfall mitigation projects on surrounding 17 hillsides in Moanalua Gardens and Moanalua Valley; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency is responsible for planning for and responding to natural and 21 22 human-caused emergencies in the State; now, therefore, 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 24 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, 25 that the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency is directed to 26 submit a hazard mitigation assistance grant request or pre-27 disaster mitigation program grant request to the Federal 28 Emergency Management Agency for rockfall mitigation in Moanalua 29 Gardens and Moanalua Valley, Oahu, under the Tripler Army 30 Medical Center hillside; and 31
