Your Committee reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by Dwight Burns for service on the Island Burial Council (Maui/Lanai).

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination for the appointment of Dwight Burns from the Department of Land and Natural Resources, Operating Engineers Local Union No. 3, and one individual.

Mr. Burns resides on Maui and will represent Makawao. He currently serves as the Maui island representative for the Hawaii Operating Engineers Industry Stabilization Fund where he monitors compliance of city, state, and federally funded construction contracts. Previously, he worked as an excavator operator. As an excavator operator, Mr. Burns worked on projects across the State and worked alongside archaeologists to ensure the best outcomes for iwi kupuna found on construction sites. Mr. Burns is also a member of Go Maui Inc., an organization that engages and represents local residents on key initiatives and issues that affect Maui's quality of life and champions for a cohesive

community on Maui. Your Committee therefore recommends that Dwight Burns be appointed to the Island Burial Council (Maui/Lanai) based on his knowledge, background, and dedication to public service.
