Your Committee on Conference on the disagreeing vote of the Senate to the amendments proposed by the House of Representatives in S.B. No. 2601, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SEXUAL ABUSE OF MINORS,"

having met, and after full and free discussion, has agreed to recommend and does recommend to the respective Houses the final passage of this bill in an amended form.

The purpose of this measure is to:

- Expand the time period by which a civil action for childhood sexual abuse committed on or after July 1, 2024, may be initiated; and
- Authorize a court to require personnel of legal entities to undergo training on trauma-informed response to allegations of sexual abuse.

Your Committee on Conference finds that many childhood sexual abuse victims withhold disclosure, often due to limited access to quality psychological care and social services. This measure will

provide victims of childhood sexual abuse additional time to come forward and seek justice against their abuser.

Your Committee on Conference has amended this measure by making it effective upon its approval.
