Sir:

Your Committee on Energy, Economic Development, and Tourism,  
to which was referred S.B. No. 3059 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE STADIUM AUTHORITY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to clarify the  
requirements to establish a quorum to do business and validate  
acts of the Stadium Authority.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure  
from the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism  
and the Stadium Authority.

Your Committee finds that existing law relating to the  
Stadium Authority does not specify the requirements for  
establishing a quorum of the members or the number of votes  
necessary to adopt a measure. Your Committee further finds that  
the Stadium Authority has had issues in meeting the general quorum  
requirement set forth in section 92-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes,  
due to vacancies of Stadium Authority members. This measure  
provides the needed clarity to ensure the Stadium Authority can  
conduct its important business.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:



- (1) Inserting language to clarify that voting members of the Stadium Authority shall elect the Chairperson;
- (2) Clarifying that a majority of the voting members currently serving on the Stadium Authority shall constitute a quorum and the concurrence of a majority of all voting members currently serving on the Stadium Authority shall be necessary to make any action valid; and
- (3) Inserting an effective date of January 1, 2060, to encourage further discussion.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Energy, Economic Development, and Tourism that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 3059, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 3059, S.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Judiciary.
