TRAFFIC UPDATE - Farrington Highway

Week of April 8, 2012

Crews will work along Farrington Highway between Acacia Road in Pearl City and Kualaka'i Parkway (North-South Road) in Kapolei. Work requiring lane and shoulder closures will consist of:

Day Traffic Impacts:

- Relocating utilities along the Diamond Head shoulder of Kualaka'i Parkway (North-South Road).
- Potholing for utilities between Fort Weaver Road and Old Fort Weaver Loop.
 - Traffic in both directions of Farrington Highway will be counter-flowed between Old Fort Weaver Road and Old Fort Weaver Road Loop on Monday, April 9 and Tuesday, April 10, and will be detoured using Old Fort Weaver Loop on Wednesday, April 11 and Thursday, April 12 from 8:30 a.m.-3 p.m.

Evening Traffic Impacts:

Utility work between Mokuola Street and Kahuali'i Street.

Farrington Highway, H-1 and City Streets Traffic Plan:

- Work will require regular lane and shoulder closures in both the eastbound and westbound directions during the following hours:
 - Daytime: Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m.-3 p.m.
 - Evenings: Sunday through Thursday from 7 p.m.-6 a.m.
- Shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road will mark the work area.
- One lane of traffic in each direction of Farrington Highway will remain open in the designated work areas.
- Please note that traffic in both directions of Farrington Highway between Fort Weaver Road and Old Fort Weaver Road will be detoured via Old Fort Weaver Loop 24 hours a day, 7 days a week beginning the week of April 16 for approximately 6 week.

TRAFFIC UPDATE - Kamehameha Highway

Week of April 8, 2012

Crews continue work along Kamehameha Highway between Pearl City and Aloha Stadium, conducting pre-engineering activities for the second section of the Honolulu rail transit project route. Work will consist of potholing to locate utilities, soil sampling and pothole restoration that require the following traffic impacts:

Day Traffic Impacts:

- East and westbound lane closures of Kamehameha Highway between:
 - Lehua Avenue to Kanuku Street
 - o Pali Momi Street to Salt Lake Boulevard

Evening Traffic Impacts:

- East and westbound lane closures of Kamehameha Highway between:
 - Kuala Street to Kalaloa Street

Kamehameha Highway, H-1 Freeway and City Streets Traffic Plan:

- Work will require lane closures with shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road to mark the work area during the following hours:
 - Daytime: Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m.-3 p.m.
 - Evenings: Sunday through Thursday evenings from 8 p.m.-5 a.m.
- One lane of traffic in each direction of Kamehameha Highway will remain open in the designated work areas.

Motorists using Kamehameha Highway are advised to drive with caution and provide a safe distance between themselves, the construction workers and vehicles.

Business & Community Meetings

Kiewit has been authorized by the Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) to enter the full construction phase of the elevated guideway from East Kapolei to Aloha Stadium. While pre-engineering activities continue in various areas along the Farrington Highway and Kamehameha Highway sections of the rail route, Kiewit will begin construction of the foundation shafts and columns.
