## **Construction Begins Jan. 13 For New MMS Building**

M liliani residents have patiently waited for Mililani Middle School to transition to a single track. I am happy to announce that the state Department of Education has issued a notice to proceed on the construction of a new classroom building so that the contractor can begin work Monday, Jan. 13.

We embarked on this project in 2014 with a simple site visit to the campus. Principal Elynne Chung invited DOE and elected officials to advo-

cate for your needs. As a result, state Sen. Michelle Kidani and I fought to put funds into the state budget for additional classrooms.

The three-story building will provide 15 classrooms (five per floor) and over 34,000 square feet of space, along with a new parking area and utilities.

It will be built on approximately 1 acre of land previously owned by the city's Department of Parks and Recreation, which was part of the adjacent Mililani Mauka Community Park. The new The three-story building will provide 15 classrooms (five per floor) and over 34,000 square feet of space.

se cost of \$14 million.

Not only is the school getting a new building, but

there also will be additional dining areas on campus so that it can accommodate the student population.
