H.B. 2071, H.D. 1 RELATING TO PHOTO RED LIGHT IMAGING DETECTOR SYSTEMS

Senate Committee on Transportation and Culture and the Arts

The Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT) **supports H.B. 2071, H.D. 1**, which provides that any photo red light imaging detector system's clear and unobstructed recorded image of a motor vehicle license plate shall be prima facie evidence that the motor vehicle to which the license plate is attached is the motor vehicle for which the license plate shall be prima facie evidence that the license plate was issued. Requires the State, the county, or the State's or county's third-party contractor to implement a process to record the date on which the summons or citation was submitted to the post office, which shall be prima facie evidence of the date the summons or citation was submitted to the post office.

The HDOT's vendor is currently working on a process to record the date on which the summons or citations was submitted to the post office. The vendor is confident that the new process could be implemented by July 2024.
