## In consideration of S.B. 2043 RELATING TO THE RENTAL HOUSING REVOLVING FUND.

HHFDC has **<u>comments</u>** on SB 2043, which prohibits HHFDC from forgiving loans made from the Rental Housing Revolving Fund (RHRF). This fund provides loans or grants for the development, pre-development, construction, acquisition, preservation, and substantial rehabilitation of rental housing units.

No RHRF loan has ever been forgiven. However, we believe that there should not be a prohibition against loan forgiveness to maintain flexibility for unforeseen financial situations that may arise. We also note that RHRF is authorized to make grants (i.e., financing which is not repaid.)
