## In consideration of SB 2200 RELATING TO ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

Chair McKelvey; Vice Chair Gabbard; and members of the Senate Committee on Government Operations:

The proposed measure would provide that a maximum time period to grant or deny a business or development-related permit, license, or approval would only apply if a request for a contested case had not been filed.

The Land Use Commission (LUC) would recommend the addition of the following language "...<u>or is</u> <u>required by law</u>" after "...a contested case has not been filed". We believe that would provide clarity that existing statutory timeframes where contested case proceedings are required would remain in place.
