Act 8, Special Session Laws of Hawai'i 2021, which amended Hawai'i Revised Statutes section 304A-2672, requires the University of Hawai'i to submit an annual report to the legislature detailing a list of all capital improvement projects approved by the Board of Regents prioritized by each campus.
