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1. Introduction

This report describes the Hawaii Emergency Management's activities and progress related to the implementation of Act 116, Session Laws of Hawai'i (SLH) 2022, Relating to Disaster Response.

This annual report fulfills the requirement in Act 116, SLH 2022 for the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency to report annually to the Governor and the Legislature regarding clarification that federal funds received by the State for reimbursement of disaster-related expenses, except for federal funds received by the Department of Education for disaster-related expenses, shall first be applied to the originating fund used by the department or agency for payment of disaster relief expenses, provided that if the original appropriation has lapsed, the funds shall be returned to the general fund. The Act also requires the administrator of the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency to submit an annual report on the status of federal reimbursement moneys for disaster response, and disaster response spending by each state department and agency.

2. State Agency Reports

Table 1 shows the expenses reported by the State agencies. Act 116 requires each state department and agency to submit to the HI-EMA administrator not later than August 1 of each year a report of all funds expended, if any, for the prior fiscal year by the state department and agency for disaster response. The report shall include the source of funds, the amount and purpose of each expenditure, and whether any programs, activities, or contracts were reduced as a result of disaster response spending by the state department and agency.

Act 116 became law on June 27, 2022 and state agencies were emailed on August 8, 2022 to provide this information. Prior to Act 116, state agencies weren't required to collect and report this information so the information was the best available information at the time of request.

In preparation for the next annual report, HI-EMA will be requesting state agencies report their disaster response expenses immediately following events where state agencies had response activities.

3. Funds Disbursed to State Agencies

Table 2 shows the funds disbursed over the past fiscal year. HI-EMA made thirty disbursements to eight state agencies. The majority of the disbursements were to HI-EMA for DR4510 COVID-19 projects that required immediate disbursements to pay vendors for COVID-19 activities. Disbursements were also issued to the Department of Health, Department of Land and Natural Resources and others.

The total days to disburse ranged from 0 to 4,038 days. These calculations aren't true measurements of how long it took for funds to be disbursed.

For hazard mitigation projects, funds were disbursed as the subrecipient requested reimbursement.

For this annual report, HI-EMA measured the days to disburse from the date the subrecipient signed the SF270 Request for Advance or Reimbursement to the date the funds were journal vouchered to the subrecipient.

4. Funds To Be Disbursed to State Agencies

Table 3 shows the funds to be disbursed over the past fiscal year, showing over \$225 million in federally obligated funds to be disbursed. Disbursements will be contingent on the subrecipients completing the approved work and submitting sufficient supporting expense documentation.

Of note are two DR4510 COVID-19 projects for the medical surge support to the hospitals. Partial disbursements been made but the final disbursements will be delayed because FEMA is still considering how the anticipated insurance proceeds calculations will be finalized. HIEMA submitted its methodology to FEMA and FEMA has accepted it. FEMA has not yet given final approval regarding this process and

has yet to begin closing projects. The anticipated insurance proceeds must be subtracted from the approved expenses to determine the eligible expenses for final reimbursement. This will likely delay final disbursements for at least 1 more year.

5. State and County-Level Events

During the fiscal year, there was only one event (Mauna Loa Lava Event) where state assets were used in response activities and a federal declaration was not requested. After the event, HI-EMA requested state agencies to submit their disaster response expenses and any event-related damage. State agencies that submitted costs for reimbursement were the Department of Health, the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands and the Department of Land and Natural Resources.

6. Conclusion

Act 116 became law on June 27, 2022, requiring state agencies to provide a assessment of the cost of a disaster event to their agency. Many agencies provide and participate in response activities and their efforts aren't documented so the cost to taxpayers isn't known.

The Act also requires any federal reimbursements to be returned to the original source of funding. If the original source of funding is no longer open, then the reimbursement is to be returned to the state's general fund. This requirement will require strong coordination between DAGS, Budget & Finance, the subrecipient and HI-EMA.
