## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUNSHINE LAW.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 members, but no later than [forty-eight hours] two business days 2 before the meeting [time], the board shall also make the board 3 packet available for public inspection in the board's office; provided that nothing in this section shall require creation of 5 a board packet[+]; provided further that nothing in this section 6 shall prohibit the distribution of public testimony to board 7 members before the meeting. The board shall provide notice to 8 persons requesting notification of meetings pursuant to section 9 92-7(e) that includes a list of the documents that were compiled 10 by the board and distributed to the board members before a 11 meeting for use at that meeting and that the board packet is 12 available for inspection in the board's office and shall provide 13 reasonably prompt access to the board packet to any person upon 14 request. The board is not required to mail board packets. As 15 soon as practicable, the board shall accommodate requests for electronic access to the board packet[+] and shall post the 16 17 board packet on its website. 18 For purposes of this section[, "board]: 19 "Board packet" means documents that are compiled by the 20 board and distributed to board members before a meeting for use

at that meeting, to the extent the documents are public under

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- 1 chapter 92F; provided that this section shall not require
- 2 disclosure of executive session minutes, license applications,
- 3 or other records for which the board cannot reasonably complete
- 4 its redaction of nonpublic information in the time available
- 5 before the public inspection required by this section.
- 6 "Business day" shall have the same meaning as in section
- 7 11-1."
- 8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
