A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RELATIVE RESOURCE CAREGIVERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 587A-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:		
3	"(a) The department shall provide [the] \underline{a} child's relative		
4	an application to be <u>licensed as</u> the child's resource family		
5	within fifteen days of the relative's request to provide foster		
6	placement for the child. The department shall issue a license		
7	only if the relative submits an application and meets the		
8	licensing standards for a child-specific license established in		
9	rules adopted by the department pursuant to chapter 91 and the		
10	child is placed with the relative. If the application is		
11	submitted and:		
12	(1) The license is denied[7] due to the failure of the		
13	applicant to meet the licensing standards set out in		
14	rules adopted by the department, the department shall		
15	provide the applicant with the specific reasons for		
16	the denial and an explanation of the procedures for an		

1		administrative appeal [-] to contest the denial based
2		on the licensing standards; or
3	(2)	The applicant meets the licensing standards set out in
4		rules adopted by the department, and the department
5		does not issue a child-specific license because the
6		child is not placed with the applicant, the applicant
7		shall not have a right to an administrative appeal to
8		contest the placement decision; provided that the
9		applicant may seek judicial review by the family court
10		with exclusive jurisdiction to review placement
11		determinations for the child pursuant to the
12		provisions of this chapter."
13	SECT	ION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14	and stric	ken. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECT	TION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
