S.B. NO. 2350 S.D. 2

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NOISE POLLUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many residents
- 2 throughout the State, especially those in high density
- 3 residential areas, have complained about growing noise pollution
- 4 and disturbances from low restriction mufflers on motor
- 5 vehicles, predominantly motorcycles. The complainants claim
- 6 that the noise level adversely affects their sleep, particularly
- 7 in the early morning hours or late at night. Thus, the noise
- 8 may have adverse impacts on public health and safety, as well as
- 9 peaceful enjoyment and quality of life.
- 10 The legislature further finds that while existing law
- 11 prohibits vehicle owners from installing mufflers that increase
- 12 the noise of their vehicle, the penalties are minimal and do
- little to deter violations. In fact, violators are known to add 13
- 14 enhanced noise mufflers after they have passed the county
- 15 vehicle safety check.
- 16 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish:

-	(+)	A separate prohibition on driving motor venicles	
2		having noisy mufflers on public highways in high	
3		density population areas;	
4	(2)	Tiered fines for violations of motor scooter muffler	
5		laws; and	
6	(3)	Tiered fines for violations of motor vehicle muffler	
7		laws.	
8	SECTION 2. Chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
9	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
10	and to read as follows:		
11	" <u>§29</u>	1- Motor vehicle muffler; high density population	
12	areas. (a) No person shall use on a public highway in a high	
13	density p	opulation area a muffler that noticeably increases the	
14	noise emi	tted by a motor vehicle above that emitted by the	
15	vehicle as equipped by the factory.		
16	(b) Any violation of this section shall constitute a		
17	violation	and shall be enforceable by law enforcement officers.	
18	Any perso	on who violates the provisions of this section may be	
19	issued a	summons or citation for the violation. Violation of	
20	any of th	ne provisions of this section shall subject the violator	
21		allowing popultion.	

1	(1)	For a first violation, the person shall be fined not
2		more than \$200;
3	(2)	For a second violation committed within five years of
4		any other violation under this section, the person
5		shall be fined not more than \$500; and
6	(3)	For a violation of a third or subsequent offense
7		committed within five years of any other violation
8		under this section, the person shall be fined not more
9		than \$1,500.
10	<u>(c)</u>	As used in this section, "high density population
11	area" mea	ns a county having a population of five hundred
12	thousand	or more."
13	SECT	'ION 3. Section 291-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended t	o read as follows:
15	"§29	1-23 Penalty. [Whoever is convicted of violating any
16	of the pr	covisions of section 291-22 shall be fined not more than
17	\$100.] <u>(</u> a	Violation of any of the provisions of section 291-22
18	shall sub	eject the violator to the following penalties:
19	<u>(1)</u>	For a first violation, the person shall be fined not
20		more than \$100;

1	(2)	For a second violation committed within five years of
2		any other violation under section 291-22, the person
3		shall be fined not more than \$300; and
4	(3)	For a violation of a third or subsequent offense
5		committed within five years of any other violation
6		under section 291-22, the person shall be fined not
7		more than \$900."
8	SECT	ION 4. Section 291-24.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9	amended t	o read as follows:
10	"[+]	§291-24.5[] Motor vehicle muffler. (a) No person
11	shall use	on a public highway, sell, alter, or install a muffler
12	[which] <u>t</u>	hat will noticeably increase the noise emitted by a
13	motor vehicle above that emitted by the vehicle as equipped from	
14	the facto	ory.
15	(b)	[Any] Except as provided in section 291- , any
16	violation	of this section shall constitute a violation and shall
17	be enforc	eable by police officers. [The fine for this violation
18	shall be	not less than \$25 nor more than \$250 for each separate
19	offense.]	Violation of this section shall subject the violator
20	to the fo	ollowing penalties:

1	(1) For a first violation, the person shall be fined not
2	more than \$100;
3	(2) For a second violation committed within three years of
4	any other violation under this section, the person
5	shall be fined not more than \$300; and
6	(3) For a violation of a third or subsequent offense
7	committed within five years of any other violation
8	under this section, the person shall be fined not more
9	than \$900.
10	Any person who violates the provisions of this section may be
11	issued a summons or citation for [such] the violation."
12	SECTION 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
13	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
14	begun before its effective date.
15	SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
