Aloha Senate President Kouchi and Speaker Saiki:

In accordance with Section 9, Article VII, of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i, I respectfully request your expeditious consideration of Senate Bill No. 582, S.D. 1 – Relating to State Budget.

The State will require additional funds to cover immediate expenses in FY 24 for non-congregate housing and expenses for individuals impacted by the wildfires who have been classified as not eligible for Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) assistance. These amounts are now expected to exceed the \$199.1 million previously transferred to the Major Disaster Fund. Though the State will seek reimbursement from FEMA for all eligible costs because the State executed the contracts for non-congregate housing and those other expenses, the State is responsible for making payment for these expenses incurred during this fiscal year.

Your consideration of this request is appreciated.
