A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT PLANNING ORGANIZATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that being designated as 1 2 an economic development district by the United States Economic 3 Development Administration offers opportunities to advance coordinated and locally developed goals that leverage and build 4 upon interrelated community assets, such as workforce, 5 6 infrastructure, and housing. An economic development district 7 advances a long-term established relationship with the United States Economic Development Administration that includes annual 8 9 federal funding to support the development and implementation of 10 the Hawaii comprehensive economic development strategy. The United States Economic Development Administration is much more 11 likely to invest federal funds in a designated economic 12 13 development district than in an area that is not covered by an economic development district. 14

15 The legislature further finds that, pursuant to Title 1316 Code of Federal Regulations section 304.1, an economic

3	(1)	A comprehensive economic development strategy that has
4		been approved by the Assistant Secretary for Economic
5		Development of the United States Department of
6		Commerce and includes a specific program for
7		intra-district cooperation, self-help, and public

9	(2)	Commitments from a majority of counties within the
10		proposed district;
11	(3)	A district organization, which may be organized under
12		state law as a multi-jurisdictional area-wide planning
13		organization; and
14	(4)	That the district organization meet requirements
15		established in Title 13 Code of Federal Regulations
16		section 304.2, including that the organization's
17		governing body be broadly representative of the
18		principal economic interests of the region by
19		involving the private sector, public officials,
20		community leaders, representatives of workforce

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1		development boards, institutions of higher learning,
2		minority and labor groups, and private citizens.
3	The	purpose of this Act is to ensure that Hawaii is
4	eligible	for the substantial benefits of a United States
5	Economic	Development Administration-designated economic
6	developme	nt district by:
7	(1)	Establishing the Hawaii economic development district
8		planning organization and governing board to be
9		administratively attached to the office of planning
10		and sustainable development; and
11	(2)	Creating full-time equivalent temporary
12		positions and appropriating funds to support the
13		operations of the Hawaii economic development district
14		planning organization.
15	SECT	ION 2. Chapter 226, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16	amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately	
17	designate	d and to read as follows:
18	" <u>§22</u>	6- Hawaii economic development district planning
19	organizat	ion. (a) There is established the Hawaii economic
20	developme	nt district planning organization, which shall be the
21	district	organization for purposes of implementing the United

3	economic d	development district planning organization shall be
4	placed wit	thin the department of business, economic development,
5	and touris	sm and attached to the office of planning and

7	<u>(b)</u>	The Hawaii economic development district planning
8	organizat	ion shall:
9	(1)	Develop, manage, and support effective multi-level
10		partnerships to promote intra-district cooperation,
11		self-help, and public investment to restore and
12		sustain economic resilience and prosperity;
13	(2)	Assist organizations within the economic development
14		district with applications for funding;
15	(3)	Implement the United States Economic Development
16		Administration-approved comprehensive economic
17		development strategy; and
18	(4)	Report to the governor and legislature regarding any
19		annual updates to the comprehensive economic
20		development strategy.

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1	<u>(c)</u>	The Hawaii economic development district planning
2	organizati	ion shall be headed by a board that shall comprise the
3	following	fifteen members:
4	(1)	The director of the office of planning and sustainable
5		development or the director's designee, who shall
6		serve as chair;
7	(2)	The mayor of each county or the respective mayor's
8		designee;
9	(3)	The executive director of each county economic
10		development board or the respective executive
11		director's designee;
12	(4)	A representative of each county workforce development
13		board, who shall be designated by the chair of the
14		respective board;
15	(5)	The president of the university of Hawaii or the
16		president's designee; and
17	(6)	A representative of a labor organization who shall be
18		appointed by the governor.
19	<u>(d)</u>	The nongovernmental members of the Hawaii economic
20	developmen	nt district planning organization board shall serve for

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1	no more than two consecutive four-year terms. Members shall not
2	be subject to section 26-34(a).
3	(e) Members of the Hawaii economic development district
4	planning organization board shall serve without compensation but
5	shall be reimbursed for expenses, including reasonable travel
6	expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties.
7	(f) The Hawaii economic development district planning
8	organization board shall hold public meetings at least twice a
9	year. The meetings shall be subject to chapter 92."
10	SECTION 3. There are established full-time
11	equivalent (.0 FTE) temporary economic development planning
12	analyst positions to support the Hawaii economic development
13	district planning organization; provided that the positions
14	shall be exempt from chapters 76 and 89, Hawaii Revised
15	Statutes; provided further that the positions shall be funded
16	using general funds.
17	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
18	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
19	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
20	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal

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year 2024-2025 to carry out the purposes of this Act, including
 the hiring of necessary staff.

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
4 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
5 of this Act.

6 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
