A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A GREEN USER FEE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 184, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$184- Green user fee program; mobile application. (a)
- 5 The department shall establish a green user fee program to
- 6 collect user fees, including film permitting fees, for state
- 7 parks identified by the department. User fees collected
- 8 pursuant to this section shall be deposited into the state parks
- 9 special fund under section 184-3.4. A county may request to
- 10 have a county park participate in the green user fee program;
- 11 provided that if the county charges a user fee, the fee shall be
- 12 collected by the department and remitted to the appropriate
- 13 county.
- 14 (b) The department shall develop a mobile application for
- 15 the green user fee program to manage reservations and collect
- 16 user fees for state parks identified by the department.

1	The mobile	e application shall be available in multiple languages
2	including	but not limited to:
3	(1)	Traditional and simplified Chinese;
4	(2)	Japanese;
5	<u>(3)</u>	Korean; and
6	(4)	Tagalog.
7	<u>(c)</u>	This section shall not apply to an individual who has:
8	(1)	Filed or paid state income taxes for the immediately
9		previous tax period; or
10	(2)	Established domicile in the State, as evidenced by
11		documentation showing the individual's address,
12		including any of the following:
13		(A) A valid state driver's license;
14		(B) A valid state civil identification card;
15		(C) A valid school identification card; or
16		(D) Any other official document issued to the
17		individual by a government agency, financial
18		institution, insurance company, or utility
19		<pre>company in the State."</pre>
20	SECT	ION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
21	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so

much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and 2 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 3 year 2024-2025 to establish the reservation and fee collection 4 system, including the mobile application, as required by this Act. 5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 7 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act. 8 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and 11 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 12 year 2024-2025 for four full-time equivalent (4.0 FTE) 13 positions, to be allocated as follows: 14 (1)for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) 15 administrator of the green user fee program; (2) \$ for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) 16 17 administrative assistant of the green user fee 18 program; 19 (3) \$ for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) 20 green user fee coordinator to coordinate with the 21 counties for the green user fee program; and

I	(4) \$ for one full-time equivalent (1.0 File)
2	film permitting liaison.
3	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
4	of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
5	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.

Green User Fee Program; State Parks; Appropriation

Description:

Requires the department of land and natural resources to establish a green user fee program to collect user fees for certain state parks. Requires the department of land and natural resources to develop a mobile application for the green user fee program. Exempts certain individuals from the green user fee program. Appropriates funds.

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
