RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The city and county of Honolulu shall transfer
- 2 to the State the city and county of Honolulu's authority to
- 3 construct a new roadway extending Makakilo drive to Kualakai
- 4 parkway.
- 5 SECTION 2. All appropriations, records, equipment,
- 6 machines, files, supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents,
- 7 maps, other personal property, or real property heretofore made,
- 8 used, acquired, or held by the city and county of Honolulu
- 9 relating to the functions transferred to the department of
- 10 transportation shall be transferred with the functions to which
- 11 they relate.
- 12 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
- 15 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 16 2024-2025 to be deposited into the state highway fund.
