## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CARE HOMES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

| 1  | SECTION 1. Section 346-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is          |
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| 2  | amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:          |
| 3  | "(c) The director, pursuant to chapter 91, shall determine      |
| 4  | the rate of payment for domiciliary care, including care        |
| 5  | provided in licensed developmental disabilities domiciliary     |
| 6  | homes, community care foster family homes, and certified adult  |
| 7  | foster homes, to be provided to recipients who are eligible for |
| 8  | federal [supplementary] supplemental security income or public  |
| 9  | assistance, or both. The director shall provide for level of    |
| 10 | care payment as follows:  |
| 11 | (1) Beginning on July 1, $[\frac{2008}{7}]$ $2023$ , for adult  |
| 12 | residential care homes classified as facility type I,           |
| 13 | licensed developmental disabilities domiciliary homes           |
| 14 | as defined under section 321-15.9, community care               |
| 15 | foster family homes as defined under section 321-481,           |
| 16 | and certified adult foster homes as defined under               |

| 1  | section 321-11.2, the state supplemental payment shall           |
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| 2  | not exceed [\$651.90;] \$767; and                                |
| 3  | (2) Beginning on July 1, $[\frac{2008}{7}]$ $2023$ , for adult   |
| 4  | residential care homes classified as facility type II,           |
| 5  | the state supplemental payment shall not exceed                  |
| 6  | [ <del>\$759.90.</del> ] <u>\$857.</u>                           |
| 7  | If the operator does not provide the quality of care             |
| 8  | consistent with the needs of the individual to the satisfaction  |
| 9  | of the department, the department may remove the recipient to    |
| 10 | another facility.  |
| 11 | The department shall handle abusive practices under this         |
| 12 | section in accordance with chapter 91.                           |
| 13 | Nothing in this subsection shall allow the director to           |
| 14 | remove a recipient from an adult residential care home or other  |
| 15 | similar institution if the recipient does not desire to be       |
| 16 | removed and the operator is agreeable to the recipient           |
| 17 | remaining, except where the recipient requires a higher level of |
| 18 | care than provided or where the recipient no longer requires any |
| 19 | domiciliary care."   |
| 20 | SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed        |
| 21 | and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.             |

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

## Report Title:

CCFFH; ARCH; DDDOM; Adult Foster Homes; Department of Human Services; State Supplemental Payments

## Description:

Beginning on 7/1/2023, requires that the state supplemental payment for type 1 adult residential care homes, licensed developmental disabilities domiciliary homes, community care foster family homes, and certified adult foster homes not exceed \$767. Beginning on 7/1/2023, requires that the state supplemental payment for type II adult residential care homes not exceed \$875. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

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
