

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL BUSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-407, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$302A-407 School bus contracts. (a) Any school bus
- 4 contract between the State and the contractor shall include a
- 5 provision requiring the contractor to equip the contractor's
- 6 vehicles with the signs and visual signals described in section
- 7 291C-95(d) and (q). The contract shall also include other
- 8 provisions as may be deemed necessary by the State for the
- 9 safety of school bus passengers and shall include provisions
- 10 requiring compliance with the rules and standards described in
- 11 section 286-181.
- 12 (b) By January 1, 2035, any school bus contract between
- 13 the State and the contractor shall require all of the
- 14 contractor's vehicles to be propelled by electric power or a
- 15 non-fossil fuel; provided that any school bus contract entered
- 16 into between the effective date of this Act and January 1, 2035,
- 17 shall include a provision that requires the contractor to

- 1 replace any contracted-for vehicle that is disposed of,
- 2 transferred, sold, or otherwise taken out of service by the
- 3 applicable contractor with a contracted-for vehicle that is
- 4 propelled by electric power or a non-fossil fuel.
- 5 [\(\frac{(b)}{}\)] (c) All moneys received from students and parents or
- 6 guardians of students by public schools for state-provided
- 7 school busing services, as authorized by section 302A-406, shall
- 8 be deposited into the school bus fare revolving fund. Except as
- 9 otherwise provided by the legislature, expenditures for the
- 10 operation of state-contracted school bus services, as authorized
- 11 by section 302A-406, shall be made from this fund."
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
