BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general 1 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to 3 4 establish full-time equivalent (FTE) permanent 5 positions within the employee staffing division of the department of human resources development for the recruitment 6 and retention of state employees. 7 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 9 human resources development for the purposes of this Act. 10 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 11 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 12 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state 13 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be 14 15 exceeded by \$ or per cent. 2	amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
