

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STUDENT INSTRUCTIONAL HOURS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 302A-251, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§302A-251 School year[; student hours.]; days. (a)
4	Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, [beginning with
5	the 2011-2013 school years, all public schools, excluding
6	charter schools and multi-track public schools, shall implement
7	a school year of one hundred eighty days, excluding professional
8	development days and other non-instructional days negotiated
9	pursuant to chapter 89.
10	(b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary:
11	(1) For the 2011-2012 school year, fifty per cent of all
12	public elementary schools in the State, excluding
13	charter schools and multi-track public schools, shall
14	implement a school year that includes nine hundred
15	fifteen student hours; and
16	(2) Beginning with the 2012-2013 school year, all public
17	elementary schools in the State, excluding charter

1	schools and multi-track public schools, shall
2	implement a school year that includes nine hundred
3	fifteen student hours.
4	(c) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, for the
5	2015-2016 school year, all public secondary schools, excluding
6	charter schools and multi-track public schools, shall implement
7	a school year that includes nine hundred ninety student hours.
8	(d) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary,
9	beginning with the 2016-2017 school year, all public schools,
10	excluding charter schools and multi-track public schools, shall
11	implement a school year of one hundred eighty days, excluding
12	professional development days and other non-instructional days
13	negotiated pursuant to chapter 89, that shall include one
14	thousand eighty student hours for both elementary and secondary
15	school grades.
16	(e) The board, in its discretion, may grant a waiver
17	to any individual school subject to the [student hours or one
18	hundred eighty day school year] requirements in this section.
19	The board shall adopt policies and procedures to grant a waiver
20	under this subsection.

I	(t) For purposes of this section, "student hours" shall
2	be inclusive of the full school day in alignment with the
3	State's general learner outcomes.
4	(g) The department of education, with the board of
5	education and office of the governor, and in consultation with
6	representatives of the affected collective bargaining units,
7	shall submit to the legislature, no later than twenty days prior
8	to the convening of the regular sessions of 2013, 2014, 2015,
9	and 2016, a report on its progress and efforts to meet the
10	requirements of subsections (a), (b), (c), and (d).]"
11	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
13	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
