A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LABOR EDUCATION ADVISORY COUNCIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the center for labor 2 education and research at the university of Hawaii, West Oahu 3 campus, was established to serve the public and labor community 4 across the State by, among other things, providing labor-related 5 education to the public and advising and assisting in the development and implementation of labor studies degree programs 6 7 in the university of Hawaii system. Additionally, the labor 8 education advisory council, which is composed of fifteen members 9 broadly representative of the trade union movement in the State, 10 advises the chancellor of the university of Hawaii, West Oahu 11 campus, on activities and programs of the center for labor education and research. 12

13 To support the efforts of the center for labor education 14 and research in serving the public and university of Hawaii 15 system, the purpose of this Act is to expand the advisory 16 capacity of the labor education advisory council to ensure that 17 its advice and recommendations on all activities and programs of

the center for labor education and research are received by the 1 2 president of the university of Hawaii. 3 SECTION 2. Section 304A-1603, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 amended to read as follows: 5 "[+]\$304A-1603[+] Labor education advisory council. There 6 is established a labor education advisory council, consisting of 7 not more than fifteen members, broadly representative of the 8 trade union movement in the State, who shall be appointed by the 9 president of the [University] university of Hawaii. The council shall be advisory to the president of the university of Hawaii 10 and chancellor of the [University] university of Hawaii, West 11 12 Oahu campus, on all activities and programs of the center for 13 labor education and research and shall assist the chancellor in 14 the assessment and evaluation of program needs for 15 implementation [-]; provided that the president and chancellor 16 shall provide written responses acknowledging and addressing the 17 council's formal advice and adoption of any resolutions. 18 Members of the council shall designate its chairperson and shall 19 serve without compensation; provided that actual travel and 20 other expenses incurred in the performance of their duties shall 21 be advanced or reimbursed."
