## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that law enforcement
2	officers are authorized to use physical force to enforce laws
3	and should be held to the highest standards to ensure that this
4	authority is not abused. Appropriate disciplinary actions
5	should be taken against law enforcement officers who commit acts
6	of misconduct. The legislature believes that states must take
7	the initiative to address officer discipline, as federal action
8	on this issue has been lacking.
9	The purpose of this Act is to require:
10	(1) Law enforcement agencies and the law enforcement
11	standards board to consult the National
12	Decertification Index and ensure the reporting of
13	officer misconduct to the Index; and
14	(2) The reporting of certain domestic violence records to
15	the National Decertification Index, notwithstanding
16	any contrary law or court order regarding the sealing
17	of those records.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 139, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "\$139- National Decertification Index; participation; reporting. (a) Before certifying or employing any law 5 6 enforcement officer, the board and the employing law enforcement 7 agency shall consult the National Decertification Index. 8 (b) The board and an employing law enforcement agency 9 shall ensure that each disciplinary action taken against a law 10 enforcement officer is reported to the National Decertification 11 Index. 12 (c) Records relevant to a law enforcement officer's acts 13 of domestic violence shall be included in any report submitted 14 pursuant to subsection (b), to the extent necessary for the 15 purposes of subsection (b), notwithstanding: 16 (1) Any other law to the contrary; or 17 (2) Any order by any state court regarding the sealing of 18 those records." 19 SECTION 3. Section 139-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 20 amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately

inserted and to read as follows:

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1	"Law enforcement agency" means:
2	(1) A county police department;
3	(2) The department of law enforcement; or
4	(3) The department of land and natural resources,
5	department of taxation, or department of the attorney
6	general.
7	"National Decertification Index" means the National
8	Decertification Index, or any successor index, as maintained by
9	the International Association of Directors of Law Enforcement
10	Standards and Training, or any successor entity."
11	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

## Report Title:

Police; Law Enforcement Standards Board; National Decertification Index; Misconduct

## Description:

Requires law enforcement agencies and the Law Enforcement Standards Board to consult the National Decertification Index and ensure reporting of officer misconduct to the Index. Requires reporting of certain domestic violence records to the National Decertification Index, notwithstanding any contrary law or court order. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

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
